- Go about 3 miles and then turn right onto Byerly Mill Road (the next road on your right after you go through the light at Rt. 29).
- Go about 1/2 mile and you will see the baptism site on your right at a sharp curve. Assuming that the ground is not too wet, you may drive straight ahead and park in the meadow area (if the ground is quite wet, just park along the edge of the road).
